FUN THINGS TO DO A SHORT DISTANCE AWAY

- 1 Independence National Historical Park Pennsylvania** – Known as the birthplace of American democracy it features the Liberty Bell, Independence Hall, Congress Hall, New Hall Military Museum, Franklin Court, Bishop White House and the Graff House. Download the park's FREE mobile app, "NPS Independence."
- 2 Philadelphia Museum of Art** – The Museum began as a legacy of the great Centennial Exhibition of 1876, held in Fairmount Park. At the conclusion of the celebrations, Exhibition Hall remained open as the Pennsylvania Museum and School of Industrial Art "for the improvement and enjoyment of the people of the Commonwealth".
- 3 Philadelphia Zoo** – America's first zoo, is a 42-acre Victorian garden that is home to more than 1300 animals, many of them rare and endangered. The zoo features a children's zoo, a paddleboat lake, a rainforest themed carousel, and many interactive and educational exhibits. Exclusively at Philadelphia Zoo is a 9-week experience that enables guest to frolic and enjoy a frozen winter wonderland—right in the middle of summer.
- 4 Reading Terminal Market** – Step outside the hotel and experience this historic farmer's market, located right across the street. The Market is the nation's oldest continuously operating farmers' market where you can enjoy virtually every type of cuisine.
